

# Nested `if` Statements

- `if-else` statement can contain simple or compound statements
  - Another `if-else` statement can be included
- **Example:**

```
if (hours < 9)
{
    if (distance > 500)
        cout << "snap";
}
else
    cout << "pop";
```

# The `if-else` Chain

- **Format:**

```
if (expression_1)
    statement1;
else if (expression_2)
    statement2;
else
    statement3;
```

- Chain can be extended indefinitely by making last statement another `if-else` statement



## Program 4.4

```
#include <iostream>
using namespace std;

int main()
{
    char marcode;

    cout << "Enter a marital code: ";
    cin  >> marcode;

    if (marcode == 'M')
        cout << "Individual is married." << endl;
    else if (marcode == 'S')
        cout << "Individual is single." << endl;
    else if (marcode == 'D')
        cout << "Individual is divorced." << endl;
    else if (marcode == 'W')
        cout << "Individual is widowed." << endl;
    else
        cout << "An invalid code was entered." << endl;

    return 0;
}
```
